

DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY PREVIOUSLY USED TO MANUFACTURE METHAMPHETAMINE

NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE PURCHASER

The *Code of Virginia* (§ 55.1-708) requires the owner of residential real property who has <u>actual knowledge</u> that the property was **(1)** previously used to manufacture methamphetamine **and (2)** has **not** been cleaned up in accordance with state guidelines* established pursuant to § 32.1-11.7 to provide a written disclosure of that fact to the prospective purchaser.
